- Developing more holistic and county-specific solutions to hunger in the Central Florida region.



## DEAR FRIENDS:

It's no surprise that gloom and doom are on the pages of annual reports this year – from government and corporate offices to civic and community-based organizations. Communities across the country face a series of hardships – and that includes record levels of requests for food. In Central Florida alone, demand has doubled.

While 2008 was a difficult year and many challenges lie ahead, Second Harvest Food Bank of Central Florida (SHFBCF) worked hard to seize opportunities and solve hunger issues, laying the groundwork for a brighter future in our area. When looking back at our

accomplishments, a clear theme emerges: *more*.

- **More food.** SHFBCF distributed nearly 19 million pounds of food last year. An all-time high.
- **More nutritious food.** Two million pounds of fresh fruits and vegetables were distributed.
- **More hungry children reached.** SHFBCF successfully expanded children's programs, including the High Five Kid Pack program in local schools, Kids Cafés, Summer Feeding sites and food distribution with thousands of families.
- **More volunteers.** SHFBCF stretched its budget by making use of more than 28,000 generously donated volunteer hours.

- **More innovation.** SHFBCF launched the Benefits Connection food stamp program, which will capture \$2 million worth of unused government food stamp benefits for families, children, senior citizens and others.
- **More efficiency.** SHFBCF received a Four-Star Charity rating from Charity Navigator – the country's largest independent charity evaluator – for sound financial health. For every dollar donated to SHFBCF, we distribute \$9 worth of groceries.

With these efforts, SHFBCF has pushed its operations to the next level. Although several obstacles have blocked our path this year and we will continue to face additional hurdles into 2009, SHFBCF has and will continue to

experience success. With this progress in mind, we look toward a promising future for Second Harvest Food Bank of Central Florida.

## Our Branches

Since 1997, the Volusia Branch of the Second Harvest Food Bank has been providing food to more than 80 non-profit organizations serving people in need.

In fiscal year 2007/2008, the Volusia Branch provided 1,623,915 pounds of food — the equivalent of 1,082,610 meals.

Founded in 2000, the Brevard Branch distributed the equivalent of 1,254,351 meals (1,881,527 pounds total) to more than 90 non-profit organizations during fiscal year 2007/2008.

## Volunteers

In fiscal year 2007/2008, 7,500 volunteers contributed 28,000 hours — the equivalent of more than 12 full-time staff members! Without this incredible human resource, the Second Harvest Food Bank could not begin to have the impact on hunger that our community needs.

# food distribution:



## General Food Distribution

Products donated by manufacturers, wholesalers, retailers, growers, and others are distributed to emergency food pantries, shelters, and other types of agencies serving needy clients. This program distributed 13,002,141 pounds of nutritious food in fiscal 2007/2008. In addition, 192,991 pounds of food were provided for disaster relief efforts.

## Kids Café

At 13 meal sites, 122,668 meals were distributed in fiscal 2007/2008. Over 490 children are served meals daily.

An amazing 1,018,644 pounds of non-perishable grocery products were collected in fiscal 2007/2008 through our Community Food Drives:

## TEFAP Distribution

The Florida Department of Agriculture awarded distribution contracts for Orange, Seminole, Lake, Brevard, Volusia and Marion counties to the Second Harvest Food Bank of Central Florida for its distribution program of government food commodities. In fiscal year 2007/2008, a total of 3,379,467 pounds of these wholesome products were made available to Central Floridians in need.

## Second Helpings

This prepared and perishable food program collected and distributed 1,080,536 pounds of food in fiscal 2007/2008 to agencies that provide onsite meals for senior citizens, shelters, soup kitchens and non-profit kids programs.



## ADEPT

Since the inception of the Agency Development, Education and Partnership Training (ADEPT) program in 2006, over 1,000 staff and volunteers from our six-county span of partner agencies have attended more than 80 classes. In its efforts to empower partner agencies through education, ADEPT is now offering a variety of trainings online, in addition to onsite trainings.

Trainings offered online will include topics such as nutrition, fundraising, board development, volunteer management and others. It is our

hope that these online trainings will serve as an additional tool that will aid in the growth and development of our partner agencies as they continue to fight hunger

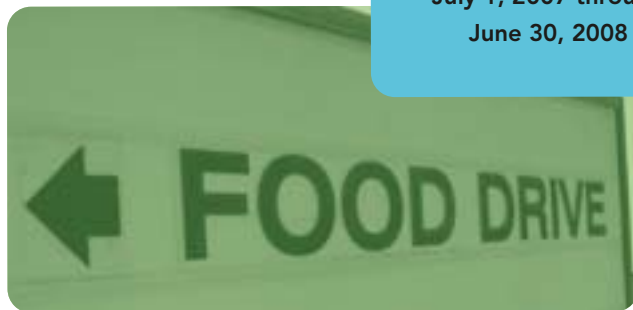
